Why to we "have to" go to Mass? - Part 1 Whether you're a 3rd grader, a grandparent, or anything in between, at some point you've probably struggled with the question, "Why do we have to go to Mass?"

- Sometimes you don't feel like going to church.
- You may not like the homilies or the music.
- Maybe you think Mass is boring.
- You may not feel welcomed.
- You might try to convince yourself that you can pray anywhere.

The Power of Negative Thinking

Even though you know that going to Mass is a good thing, you can talk yourself out of going by focusing on the negatives. At first, you may feel a little guilty, but eventually, you can justify your decision by convincing yourself that you are too busy, too tired, too bored, too frustrated.

When that happens, you miss the great gift that God gives us in the Eucharist!



Thinking Positively

What if you changed your attitude about going to Mass? What if you began to think of Mass as the time in the day when you can connect with God and with other people in a special way? What if you concentrated on the things you like about your parish instead of what you don't like? What if you made Mass a priority?

The effects of these kinds of positive attitudes may surprise you. Research studies show that people who go to church every week are:

- Less likely to suffer from depression.
- Less likely to abuse drugs or alcohol.
- More likely to have a solid sense of right and wrong.
- More likely to live a longer and happier life.
