Confundit ("Hope Does Not Disappoint") calls us to reflect this year on God's boundless mercy and embrace our mission to live out the Gospel in everyday life.

Pope Francis has granted special Indulgences to the faithful who observe and take part in the celebration of the 2025 Jubilee of Hope. HOW? By participating in any Pilgrimage to the designated Jubilee pilgrimage sites, and while fulfilling the usual conditions, one may gain this special Indulgence, which is removal of the temporal punishment due for our sins. The Pilgrimage could be by an individual, a family group, or a group of the faithful from a parish organization.

WHAT MUST ONE DO IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THIS YEAR'S SPECIAL PLENARY INDULGENCE?

- 1. make sacramental Confession before, during, or after visiting a designated Jubilee pilgrimage site
- 2. receive the Eucharist at Mass before, during or after visiting a designated Jubilee pilgrimage site
- 3. make a profession of faith and offer prayers for the Holy Father's intentions
- 4. Perform works of mercy (e.g., visiting the sick, helping the disabled, etc.)
- 5. Be free from all attachment to sin. (stop your habitual sins and turn them into good works)

Where are these Pilgrimage sites?

Hint: They are not all in Rome. They will be listed in next week's bulletin.

A plenary indulgence is a special grace that completely removes the temporal punishment for sins already forgiven, cleansing the soul as if the person had just been baptized.

HOW DOES A PLENARY INDULGENCE WORK?

To understand how a plenary indulgence works, it's important to understand sin, forgiveness, and temporal punishment:



Sin and Forgiveness: When we sin, God forgives us through the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). After forgiveness is received, consequences or effects caused by the sin may remain. These effects

need healing. Temporal Punishment: This is the effect

of sin that needs to be healed after forgiveness is granted. Spiritually, temporal punishment is a way of restoring and healing the relationship with God and

others, often seen as purification that can happen in this life or in purgatory after death.
