Dear Parishioners,

Each of us knows the importance of bread in a human's life. It is the basis of our lives. We see how many people are suffering today because of the lack of bread and how many

people are dying of hunger. Each of us needs daily bread, needs food to be able to live, function and grow.

Many people have bread in abundance, and yet they still die. However, it is not bodily death, but spiritual, because they forget about the food that gives eternal life. They forget about the Eucharistic bread, they forget about Christ. It seems to them that they are self-sufficient. Meanwhile, just as our body needs bread, food, to function normally, our soul needs the Eucharistic bread to spiritually grow. Our consciences need food from heaven to give us the right direction to make the right choices.

Christ wants to feed each of us with the Bread that gives eternal life. He wants to feed each one of us with His Body, the bread that gives eternal life, giving true freedom, freedom of God's children.

Today, St. Paul in the letter to the Ephesians, gives us a clue and instructions on what our relationship with another human being should be to be called God's children: "All bitterness, fury, anger, shouting, and reviling must be removed from you, along with all malice. And be kind to one another, compassionate, forgiving one another as God has forgiven you in Christ. So be imitators of God, as beloved children, and live in love, as Christ loved us and handed himself over for us as a sacrificial offering to God as a fragment aroma."

To enjoy true freedom, to remove bitterness, anger, resentment, to be a child of God - we should feed on Bread that gives us eternal life, as often as possible. Because a man without God dies – but with God he cannot die...



Drodzy Parafianie,

Każdy z nas doskonale wie, jak potrzebny jest chleb człowiekowi. Jest to podstawa naszego życia. Widzimy, jak wiele osób cierpi dziś z powodu braku chleba, jak wiele osób dziś umiera z głodu. Każdy

z nas potrzebuje codziennego chleba, potrzebuje pokarmu, aby móc żyć, funkcjonować i rozwijać się.

Wiele osób ma chleba pod dostatkiem, a mimo to umierają. Jednak nie jest to śmierć cielesna, ale duchowa, ponieważ zapominają o pokarmie, który daje życie wieczne, zapominają o Chlebie Eucharystycznym, zapominają o Chrystusie. Wydaje się im, że są samowystarczalni. A tym czasem – tak jak nasze ciało potrzebuje chleba, pokarmu, aby normalnie funkcjonować, tak nasza dusza potrzebuje Chleba Eucharystycznego, aby mogła się rozwijać. Nasze sumienia potrzebują pokarmu z nieba, aby nam podsuwać właściwe wskazówki, jak powinniśmy postępować.

Chrystus chce karmić każdego z nas Chlebem dającym życie wieczne, chce nakarmić każdego z nas Swoim Ciałem, chlebem dającym życie wieczne, dającym prawdziwą wolność, wolność dzieci Bożych.

Św. Paweł w Liście do Efezjan daje nam dziś wskazówkę i pouczenie, jakie powinny być nasze relacje z drugim człowiekiem, abyśmy mogli się nazywać dziećmi Bożymi: "Niech zniknie spośród was wszelka gorycz, uniesienie, gniew, wrzaskliwość, znieważanie – wraz z wszelką złością. Bądźcie dla siebie nawzajem dobrzy i miłosierni. Przebaczajcie sobie nawzajem, tak jak i Bóg nam przebaczył w Chrystusie. Bądźcie więc naśladowcami Boga jako dzieci umiłowane i postępujcie drogą miłości, bo i Chrystus was umiłował i samego siebie wydał za nas w ofierze i dani na wdzięczną wonność Bogu".






