





Drodzy Parafianie,

"Tyś jest mój Syn umiłowany, w Tobie mam upodobanie" – w takich słowach Bóg Ojciec zwrócił się do Jezusa zaraz po tym, jak przyjął od Jana Chrzciciela chrzest w Jordanie. Te same słowa Bóg

kieruje do każdego z nas, pragnąc nam przypomnieć o naszej wielkiej godności, jaką zostaliśmy obdarowani podczas naszego chrztu – godności bycia chrześcijaninem, umiłowanym synem, umiłowaną córką Boga Ojca. Każdy z nas jest bowiem niepowtarzalny, jedyny w swoim rodzaju – dlatego tak bardzo jesteśmy przez Boga kochani.

Poprzez sakrament chrztu św. Bóg zmył z naszej duszy grzech pierworodny i na nowo przyjął nas jako swoje ukochane dzieci. Świadomość, że jesteśmy dziećmi Bożymi, może być dla nas źródłem niewyobrażalnej siły, duchowej odwagi i radosnego podejmowania wyzwań wiążących się z codziennym chrześcijańskim życiem. Życie chrześcijanina nie jest tylko pasmem sukcesów i niczym niezmąconej radości, ale nieustannym duchowym bojem staczanym o to, by nikt i nic innego nie zajęło w naszym sercu pierwszorzędnego miejsca przynależnego tylko Bogu. Mając świadomość tak wielkiej miłości, jaką ukochał nas Bóg, każdy życiowy bój możemy stoczyć zwycięsko, jeśli tylko będziemy starali się każdego dnia rozwijać wiarę i na niej budować całą naszą teraźniejszość i przyszłość.

Jeśli ich nie znamy, można zasięgnąć wiadomości u swoich krewnych albo w kancelarii parafialnej, gdzie znajdują się księgi chrztów. Może moglibyśmy odwiedzić kościół i stanąć przy chrzcielnicy, przy której otrzymaliśmy chrzest święty. W ten sposób


