Dear Parishioners,

Today's readings speak of the mystery of suffering and death in the lives of all people. It is made clear that God made us for life and for health, and that whatever the meaning of the existence of

suffering and death in this world, we must continue to trust that God only has our good in mind.

God does not desire that there be suffering, illness and pain in the world. God designed us for life to the fullest and for health and strength. God is present in our midst, offering comfort and strength, and God is at work amongst us offering us healing (of one form or another) in times of illness, difficulty and pain.

We are invited to trust that God is always with us. Jesus shows us that God is suffering along with all those who labor and are heavily burdened. Jesus also shows us that God is working to lift their burdens in this life and give them fullness of life in the next.

The faith and the trust of the two people in the Gospel this weekend fill us with hope too. Jesus' compassion towards them shows us God's deep and abiding compassion towards all people too. God cares deeply and eternally about all people, especially those suffering and in pain. God is eternally faithful to them and keeps them in His care and love. God will never forget us or abandon us.

This weekend's Gospel is wonderful. I love that part where the lady quietly touches Jesus' clothes in the trust that Jesus has the power to save her. Jesus' reaction is amazing. He IMMEDIATELY knows that power had gone out from him. He asks a question that stumps the disciples: "Who has touched my clothes?" But his disciples said to Jesus, "You see how the crowd is pressing upon you, and yet you ask, 'Who touched me?"" The reaction of the disciples is understandable: "What is he talking about, everyone is touching his clothes; there is a crowd pressing in on him from every side, but still he asks, 'who touched me?""

But Jesus knew exactly what he was asking. He KNEW that all kinds of people were touching him. But he knew even more that only one person had touched him with the purposefulness and clarity of faith and trust in WHO he is and WHAT he could do, and the SIGNIFICANCE of his mission. Jesus stopped because he sensed that this wonderful lady who had suffered so long had dared to break cultural taboos and risked ignoring the rules of the religious law because she believed that Jesus had the power to save her. She was right, and Jesus praised her for her faith.

That woman's actions were deliberate, purpose-filled and faith-filled, and this is what Jesus commended. Whatever we do in life, whenever we pray and think about what we should be doing and then set about purposefully doing what we believe is right and good and according to God's plans, then we too are commended and encouraged by our Lord in our faith-filled decisions and choices.

May we too trust and believe in hope that Jesus has the power to save us, to heal us and to forgive us, and to give us the eternal life that he has promised us.





Drodzy Parafianie,

Dzisiejsze czytania mówią o tajemnicy cierpienia i śmierci w życiu każdego człowieka. Bóg stworzył nas po to aby żyć w zdrowiu i niezależnie jakie znaczenia ma cierpienie i śmierć na tym świecie, musimy nadal ufać, że Bóg

chce tylko naszego dobra.

Bóg nie pragnie cierpienia, choroby i bólu na świecie. Bóg stworzył nas by żyć pełnią życia, w zdrowiu i pełni sił. Bóg jest obecny pośród nas, oferując pocieszenie i ukojenie. Bóg działa wśród nas, oferując nam uzdrowienie (w takiej czy innej formie) podczas choroby, trudności i bólu.

Jesteśmy zaproszeni by z ufnością wierzyć, że Bóg jest zawsze z nami i że Jezus pokazuje nam Boga, który cierpi wraz z wszystkimi, którzy pracują i są bardzo obarczeni problemami. Pokazuje nam jak Bóg działa, podnosząc ich ciężary w tym życiu i daje pełnię życia wiecznego.

religijnego prawa, zaufała w Jezusową moc. Miała rację, a Jezus pochwalił ją za jej głęboką wiarę. Zachowanie tej kobiety było celowe, wypełnione wiarą i ufnością, i to jest to czego Jezus oczekuje od nas. Cokolwiek robimy w życiu, ilekroć modlimy się o podjęcie odpowiedniej decyzji a potem to realizujemy zgodnie z Bożymi planami, to my również jesteśmy pochwaleni i zachęcani przez Pana w naszych wyborach opartych na wierze.






