

#### From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

We hear the amazing two prong response of Jesus to Peter in the Gospel. First, it's Peter's profession of faith in Jesus, "You are the Christ". Then comes the whammy,

"Get behind me Satan." We need to learn a lot about ourselves as we learn about Peter. A quote from the classic Catholic author, Frank Sheed can shed some light on this dualism, this back and forth quality of our lives.

"Never think that the way of man is prosaic, (that is simple, or one dimensional). We are a mixture of matter and spirit, and in this we resemble no other creature on earth. We are the only beings who die and do not stay dead: it seems an odd way to our goal that as the last stage on the way to it, all of us, saint and sinner, should fall apart. We are the only beings with an everlasting destiny who have not reached their "final state". By comparison there is something cozy and settled about angels, for they are simply either good or bad. Men are the only beings whose destiny is uncertain... We are the only creatures who can choose what side we want to be on for our final destiny. We are the only beings left who can either choose or refuse God."

Jesus of course knew all about heaven, hell and purgatory. Peter did not. Jesus knew our life in this world required lots of choices. But for the most part, all the important choices we make fall under the two prongs of today's gospel. First, we must make a choice that we accept, we believe, we adore Christ as the living God. All our catechism, all our doctrines and creedal beliefs flow from this first choice. But there is a second choice that flows from this first. It involves the taking up of our particular cross. Rejecting the cross in this world snuffs out our commitment to the first choice. How could Peter have known all this? How is it that we choose to ignore this "odd mixture of life", as Frank Sheed calls it? For me, the answer lies in the fact that we do not think enough about heaven, hell and purgatory. We may know what they mean. We may even accept them as realities. But we don't really consider them as our ultimate destiny very often.

And here is where the second reading sheds light on the problems with the easier spiritual road of Martin Luther and all the "reformers". St James reminds us, "faith of itself, if it does not have works is dead." Pray every day that God will show you the reward for carrying your cross. Pray our society will correct our most grievous errors. I saw a billboard the other day: "Welcome to Chicago, where abortion is healthcare". Can't you hear Jesus responding, "Chicago, get behind me Satan"?



Where do you begin?


Well, you just begin from where you are right now!

Many adults who are entering the Catholic Church, or even those who are thinking about it, follow a process called "OCIA" (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, formerly called RCIA).

If you are interested or have questions, please contact Trish Nickleski at tnickleski@sscmlemont.org, even if you are an adult baptized Catholic but haven't received First Holy Communion or Confirmation.

If possible, please fill out the OCIA Application Form which is available in the back of the church and bring it to the Parish Office.

Classes began September 24, 2024, and end a couple of weeks after Easter. Classes are held in conjunction with St. Alphonsus / St. Patrick Parish. We meet on Tuesday evenings in the St. Alphonsus Ministry Building from 7-8:30 PM.



Many Catholics want to read the Bible because they know it is God's Word, but they give up because it seems so complicated. ## SS. Cyril & Methodius Parish "United in Faith"



#### Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

W dzisiejszej Ewangelii słyszymy niesamowitą, dwutorową odpowiedź Jezusa na słowa Piotra. Najpierw jest to Credo czyli Wyznanie Wiary: "Ty jesteś Mesjaszem". A potem przychodzi szokująca odpowiedź: "Zejdź mi z oczu,

szatanie". Musimy wiele nauczyć się o sobie, analizując życie Piotra. Cytat z klasycznego katolickiego autora, Franka Sheeda, może rzucić trochę światła na ten dualizm czyli zmienną naturę naszego życia.

"Nigdy nie myśl, że droga człowieka jest prozaiczna, czyli prosta lub jednowymiarowa. Jesteśmy mieszaniną materii i ducha, i pod tym względem nie przypominamy żadnego innego stworzenia na ziemi. Jesteśmy jedynymi istotami, które umierają, ale nie pozostają martwe: wydaje się to dziwną drogą do naszego celu, że na ostatnim etapie tej drogi wszyscy, zarówno święci, jak i grzesznicy, powinni się rozpadać. Jesteśmy jedynymi istotami z wiecznym przeznaczeniem, które jeszcze nie osiągnęły swojego "ostatecznego stanu". W porównaniu z nami anioły wydają się być w pewnym sensie "przytulne" i ustabilizowane, ponieważ są po prostu dobre albo złe. Ludzie są jedynymi istotami, których przeznaczenie jest niepewne... Jesteśmy jedynymi stworzeniami, które mogą wybrać, po której stronie chcą stanąć dla swojego ostatecznego przeznaczenia. Jesteśmy jedynymi istotami, które mogą albo wybrać, albo odrzucić Boga."

Jezus oczywiście wiedział wszystko o niebie, piekle i czyśćcu, natomiast Piotr nie. Jezus wiedział, że nasze życie na tym świecie wymaga wielu wyborów. Jednak w większości przypadków, wszystkie ważne decyzje, które podejmujemy, wpisują się w dwie kwestie dzisiejszej Ewangelii. Po pierwsze, musimy dokonać wyboru, że akceptujemy, wierzymy i adorujemy Chrystusa jako żywego Boga. Cała nasza katolicka wiara i wszystkie nasze doktryny wypływają z tego pierwszego wyboru. Ale jest też drugi wybór, który wynika z tego pierwszego. Chodzi o podjęcie naszego konkretnego krzyża. Odrzucenie krzyża na tym świecie gasi nasze zaangażowanie w ten pierwszy wybór. Zastanawia mnie jak Piotr mógł to wszystko zrozumieć? Jak to możliwe, że wybieramy ignorowanie tej "dziwnej mieszanki życia" określone przez Franka Sheed. Dla mnie odpowiedź leży w tym, że nie myślimy wystarczająco często o niebie, piekle i czyśćcu, pomimo tego, że wiemy co one oznaczają. Możemy to wszystko nawet akceptować jako rzeczywistość życia. Ale rzadko rozważamy je jako nasze ostateczne przeznaczenie. I tutaj drugie czytanie rzuca światło na problemy związane z łatwiejszą duchową drogą Marcina Lutra i wszystkich

"reformatorów". Święty Jakub przypomina nam: "Wiara bez uczynków jest martwa". Módl się każdego dnia, aby Bóg pokazał ci nagrodę za niesienie swojego krzyża. Módl się, aby nasze społeczeństwo poprawiło swoje najbardziej rażące błędy. Widziałem niedawno billboard: "Witamy w Chicago, gdzie aborcja jest opieką zdrowotną". Czy nie słyszysz, jak Jezus odpowiada: "Chicago, zejdź mi z oczu, szatanie"?






