

From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

"The child lept in her womb." Moms have a unique insight into this miracle of Christmas. Let's thank God that some young couples bravely welcome children these days. Those of us who are not at that time of life, need to help

those who could use a little help. It's a very Christmasy thing to do.

The reading from Hebrews 10 draws us into the high ideals of living our faith too. Although St Paul reminds his Jewish friends that God is not so much pleased with holocausts, we are supposed to pray, "Here I am, coming to obey your will."

On this, the Sunday before Christmas, I wish to encourage as many people as possible to invite, bribe or otherwise fenagle loved ones to come to Christmas Mass who don't usually go to church. For such people, attending Mass is primarily seen as a favor to the one who invited them. For them it feels like a sacrifice of their precious time and energy. So, even if their attendance isn't driven by the higher virtue of the love of God made present in the Eucharist at least they are offering a sacrifice in His name.

This is where Hebrews 10 comes in. Look closely at what St Paul says. "This will was for us to be made holy..." Whose will is St Paul talking about? God's will for us of course. What is His ultimate will for us? To obey His laws, not out of mere obedience but out of love. We need to see there is a stark difference between "just obeying laws" and "doing another's will out of true love". In other words, there is a stark difference between going to church out of obedience to a friend, or even to God and wanting to run to Mass out of a love for the one you encounter there. St Paul knows this distinction all too well. Yet, he masterfully connects our feeble acts of obedience to His commandments and what truly is the

highest act of love humanly possible. What's the highest act of love humanly possible? To lay down your life for your friends of course. St Paul uses the word katargeō when he says, "God is abolishing the first sort to replace it with the second." It can seem like obedience is being abolished to make room for love. But katargeō also means, "setting aside" or "make room for" as in "step aside from something lower to make room for something or someone higher".

You must be blind as a bat not to see that when Jesus offers His life on the cross out of obedience He is at one and the same time showing us an example of obedience and an example of ultimate love. "Works matter".

This theme is so important for our reluctant friends who maybe "dragged" to church because they always feel that the sacrifice that going to church requires isn't worth the effort. Everyone knows the meaning of sacrifice. Every time we do something we don't want to do, like going to work or doing the laundry, we experience sacrifice. But there's a slight chance that in going to church they will see what St Paul saw. God came to earth to die for our salvation. Knowing this, looking at the manger should move us to tears.





Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

"Dziecię poruszyło się w jej łonie." Muszę przyznać że nasze mamy mają wyjątkowy sposób zrozumienia cudu Bożego Narodzenia. Podziękujmy Bogu za to, że niektóre młode pary odważnie wkraczają w macierzyństwo i przyjmują dzieci

w dzisiejszych czasach. Natomiast Ci z nas, którzy przeszli już ten etap życia, powinni ich wspierać gdy borykają się ze swymi problemami i potrzebują pomocy. Okazanie takiego wsparcia jest wyjątkowo Bożonarodzeniowe.

Dzisiejsze czytanie z Listu do Hebrajczyków (Hbr 10) zachęca nas także do życia w najwyższych ideałach naszej wiary. Nawet gdy św. Paweł przypomina swoim żydowskim przyjaciołom, że Bóg nie znajduje upodobania w zagładzie ludzkiego życia, to jednak powinniśmy modlić się słowami: "Oto idę, aby spełnić Twoją wolę."

W tę niedzielę przed Bożym Narodzeniem chciałbym zachęcić jak najwięcej osób, aby zaprosili, namówili, a nawet "podstępem" sprowadzili swoich bliskich na Bożonarodzeniową Mszę Świętą, szczególnie tych, którzy zwykle nie chodzą do kościoła. Dla takich osób uczestnictwo we Mszy jest przede wszystkim przysługą wyświadczoną temu, kto ich zaprosił. W ich oczach to ofiara ich cennego czasu i energii. Nawet jeśli ich obecność nie wynika z wyższej cnoty miłości do Boga obecnego w Eucharystii, to przynajmniej składają ofiarę w Jego imieniu.

Przyjrzyjmy się uważnie czytaniu, 10 rodział Listu do Hebrajczyków. Zwróćmy uwagę na słowa św. Pawła: "Tą wolą jest nasze uświęcenie..." Czyją wolą? Oczywiście wolą Bożą wobec nas. Jaka jest Jego ostateczna wola wobec nas?

Byśmy przestrzegali Jego przykazań, nie z czystego posłuszeństwa, ale z miłości do Boga. Musimy dostrzec wyraźną różnicę między "po prostu przestrzeganiem praw" a "spełnianiem woli wypływającej z prawdziwej miłości." Innymi słowy, istnieje wyraźna różnica między chodzeniem do kościoła z posłuszeństwa wobec przyjaciela lub Boga, a pragnieniem uczestnictwa we Mszy z miłości do Tego, kogo tam spotykamy. Św. Paweł doskonale zna tę różnicę. Jednak w mistrzowski sposób łączy nasze słabe akty posłuszeństwa z Jego przykazaniami i tym, co naprawdę jest najwyższym aktem miłości możliwym dla człowieka.

A co jest najwyższym aktem miłości możliwym dla człowieka? Oczywiście oddanie życia za przyjaciół. Św. Paweł używa słowa katargeō, gdy mówi: "Bóg znosi to pierwsze, aby ustanowić to drugie." Może się wydawać, że posłuszeństwo zostaje zniesione, aby zrobić miejsce miłości. Ale

katargeō oznacza również "odstawić na bok" lub "zrobić miejsce", to tak, jak "ustąpić czemuś lub komuś wyższemu".

Trzeba być ślepym jak kret, by nie zauważyć, że gdy Jezus oddaje swoje życie na krzyżu z posłuszeństwa, jednocześnie pokazuje nam przykład posłuszeństwa i przykład najwyższej miłości. "Dobre uczynki mają znaczenie."

Jest to ważny temat dla naszych opornych przyjaciół, którzy być może zostali "zaciągnięci" do kościoła, bo zawsze czują, że ofiara związana z pójściem na Mszę nie jest warta wysiłku. Wszyscy rozumiemy, czym jest ofiara. Za każdym razem, gdy robimy coś, na co nie mamy ochoty – idziemy do pracy czy robimy pranie – doświadczamy ofiary. Ale jest szansa, że podczas pójścia do kościoła zobaczą to, co zobaczył św. Paweł. Bóg przyszedł na ziemię, by umrzeć dla naszego zbawienia. Mając to na myśli i wpatrując się w żłóbek powinniśmy wzruszyć się do łez.




