Dear Parishioners,

The fight for a prestigious position is a phenomenon as old as the world. There is practically no field of work without uphill battle, a ruthless fight for influence, positions or professional promotions. The struggle for prestigious positions often goes hand

in hand with the desire to exalt above others, to subjugate them, to use them for our own benefit.

As shown in today's Gospel, even the disciples of Jesus did not resist the temptation to fight for a prestigious position. Their Teacher recently spoke about His passion, death and resurrection, while his closest disciples, James and John, were already thinking about their privileges. They are convinced that since they are so close to Jesus, they should also have something to say, co-rule, and co-decide in His messianic kingdom. They expect privileges and want to settle them with Jesus in advance.

Jesus respected their request with understanding, but at the same time He decidedly corrected their thinking. "You do not know what you are asking for" (Mk 10,38). He does not claim that the desire for greatness and the pursuit of promotion is reprehensible, but He underlines with full force that real greatness is achieved on the path of service. Service is the only way to real greatness — in present day, in times of brutal struggle for first places. Christ is calling us to seek greatness in today's world. Our busy lives with our own affairs, constantly want to be appreciated, noticed, and have meaning. Jesus tells everyone: if you want to be the first, become a servant of everyone.

This is the most realistic proposal. Just look around carefully. We will notice that so many of our brothers and sisters humbly serve God and every human being. They devote their time, health and talents, and their humble service to others. They do not treat it as humiliation or something unworthy. Many of these people are a blessing to our Church, to the parish. Let us believe that each of us has enough gifts and talents to follow the same path.





celebrate the Anointing of the Sick at the 11 AM
Mass. This will be a bilingual (English-Polish)
Mass.

We extend an invitation to those in our Lemont Catholic Family who feel that the Celebration of Anointing will provide help for them in sickness and aging of their bodies.

In the past, the anointing was done near the time of death. Theology today understands anointing as the Sacrament of the Sick rather than at the time of approaching death. The Anointing of the Sick is the prayer of Christ and His Church for the physical and spiritual health of the sick person.

Who may be anointed?

- A sick person may be anointed before he/she undergoes surgery, whether or not the surgery is serious.
- Persons with chronic illness.
- Older persons, even if they are not suffering from dangerous illness.
- Mentally disabled persons and chemically dependent persons.
- * A sick child may be anointed in order to be comforted and uplifted by the Sacrament.





Drodzy Parafianie,

Walka o stołki to zjawisko stare jak świat. Nie ma praktycznie dziedziny bez niekończących się przepychanek, bezpardonowej walki o wpływy, stanowiska, czy awanse zawodowe. Z walką o stołki idzie często w parze chęć wywyższenia się nad innych,

podporządkowania ich sobie, wykorzystania dla własnej korzyści.

Dzisiejsza Ewangelia mówi, że pokusie walki o stołki nie oparli się nawet uczniowie Jezusa. Nauczyciel mówił przed chwilą o swojej bliskiej męce, śmierci i zmartwychwstaniu, a Jego najbliżsi uczniowie Jakub i Jan myślą o pierwszych miejscach, o przywilejach. Są przekonani, że skoro są tak blisko Jezusa, powinni mieć również coś do powiedzenia, współrządzić, współdecydować w Jego mesjańskim królestwie. Oczekują przywilejów i chcą je sobie załatwić u Jezusa wystarczająco wcześnie.

Pan Jezus potraktował ich prośbę z wyrozumiałością, ale jednocześnie bardzo zdecydowanie skorygował ich myślenie. "Nie wiecie, o co prosicie" (Mk 10,38). Nie twierdzi, że pragnienie wielkości i dążenie do awansów jest czymś nagannym, ale podkreśla z całą mocą, że prawdziwą wielkość osiąga się na drodze służby. Służba to jedyna droga do prawdziwej wielkości – również dzisiaj, w czasach brutalnej walki o pierwsze miejsca. Do ubiegania się o taką wielkość wzywa nas dzisiaj Chrystus. Nas, zabieganych o własne sprawy, którzy chcemy być docenieni, zauważeni, chcemy coś znaczyć. Mówi do każdego: chcesz być pierwszym, stań się sługą wszystkich.

Jest to propozycja jak najbardziej realna. Wystarczy uważnie rozejrzeć się wokół siebie. Zobaczymy wówczas, że tylu naszych braci i sióstr, bez szumnych deklaracji o służbie państwu, ludziom, o pięknych intencjach, bez kamer telewizyjnych, służy Bogu i ludziom. Którzy poświęcają swój czas, zdrowie i talenty. Którzy swojej cichej i pokornej służby bliżnim, nie traktują jako poniżenia, umniejszenia, czegoś niegodnego. Wielu takich ludzi jest bogactwem naszego Kościoła, parafii. Uwierzmy, że również każdy z nas posiada wystarczające dary i talenty, aby podążać tą sama drogą.

"The Children's Liturgy of the Word"

Be part of something new as you love God and serve his people.

Why? To help small children grades K-4 to better understand the Sunday readings and how the holy scriptures apply to their young lives.

How will it work?

- 1. Families with participating children will sit in the front seven pews in church during 9:30 AM Sunday Mass.
- 2. After the opening Mass prayers, a children's catechist and aide will approach the altar, and the children will quietly line up behind them.
- 3. The priest celebrating Mass will bless the group, and then they devoutly move from front of the church to the PLB meeting room.






