

Dear Parishioners,

The annual celebration of Our Lady of Częstochowa is August 26. The image of the "Black Madonna," whose copy we have in our church, is Poland's holiest and most important relic. Its sanctuary is

visited by hundreds of thousands of pilgrims every year.

The first reference to the painting comes from the first half of the fifteenth century. The monastery documents: "The author of the painting is Saint Luke the Evangelist. At the request of the faithful, he painted the image of Mary with the Baby on the table at which she sat. The Emperor Constantine ordered to transfer the image from Jerusalem to Constantinople and place it in the temple. There the picture became famous for its miracles."

A popular legend also tells, that in Ladislaus' time, a Tartar arrow struck the painting leaving a mark on the Virgin's throat. In 1430, Hussites stole it and vandalized it. Not only did they break it into three pieces, but one of the robbers took his sword and left two gashes in the image. As he was getting ready to leave the third, he fell on the ground and flailed in agony until he died.

Częstochowa is regarded as the most popular shrine in Poland, with many Polish Catholics making a pilgrimage there every year. Throughout the month of August, walking pilgrims head to the shrine from every corner of Poland. The pilgrimage can last between three to fourteen days covering up to 200 miles. Pope John Paul II secretly visited the shrine as a student pilgrim during World War II and had visited the shrine officially as Pope each time he traveled to his native country.

The American National Shrine of Our Lady of Czestochowa is located in Doylestown, Pennsylvania. Our Lady of Częstochowa, pray for us. Happy Feast!

Drodzy Parafianie,

26 sierpnia, to dzień dorocznej uroczystości Matki Bożej Częstochowskiej. Obraz "Czarnej Madonny", którego kopię mamy w naszym kościele, to chyba najsłynniejszy wizerunek Matki Bożej

w Polsce. Jej sanktuarium co roku odwiedza setki tysięcy pielgrzymów.

Pierwsza wzmianka o obrazie pochodzi z pierwszej połowy XV wieku. W dokumentach klasztoru czytamy: "Autorem obrazu jest św. Łukasz Ewangelista. Na prośbę wiernych wymalował wizerunek Maryi z Dzieciątkiem na blacie stołu, przy którym siadywała. Cesarz Konstantyn kazał przenieść obraz z Jerozolimy do Konstantynopola i umieścić w świątyni. Tam obraz zasłynął cudami. Urzeczony cudownym obrazem książę ruski Lew, pozostający w służbie cesarza, uprosił Konstantyna o darowanie mu obrazu, który też przeniósł do swojego księstwa i kazał go bogato ozdobić. Obraz znowu zasłynął cudami. W czasie wojny prowadzonej na Rusi przez Ludwika Węgierskiego obraz ukryto w zamku bełskim. Po poddaniu się zamku Ludwikowi namiestnik króla, książę Władysław Opolczyk zajął obraz. W czasie oblegania zamku przez Litwinów i Tatarów strzała wpadła do zamku i ugodziła w prawą stronę wizerunku. Wtedy nieprzyjaciół otoczyła mgła, która ich przeraziła. Książę wypadł na nich z wojskiem i ich rozgromił. Kiedy chciał wywieźć obraz do swojego księstwa, mimo dużej liczby koni wóz z obrazem nie ruszał z miejsca. Wtedy książę uczynił ślub, że wystawi kościół i klasztor tam, gdzie umieści obraz. Wtedy konie lekko ruszyły i zawiozły obraz na Jasną Górę. Tam książę umieścił go w kaplicy kościoła, gdzie obraz ponownie zajaśniał cudami".

Popularna legenda głosi, że istniejące na obrazie rany są pozostałością po napadzie husytów na klasztor w roku 1430. Weszli oni do klasztoru w poszukiwaniu cennych skarbów, które miały być tam ukryte. Nie znjadując cennych przedmiotów zniszczyli oni obraz zadając Mu ciosy mieszczem.






