

Our school is extremely grateful for their support! We are more than two-thirds of the way to achieving our goal!



Jan Chrzciciel miał wielu bardzo uważnych słuchaczy. Byli to przede wszystkim celnicy i żołnierze, którzy w skupieniu wsłuchiwali się w to, co mówił. A przecież było to tylko zwyczajne kazanie nad Jordanem,

w którym Jan wzywał do nawrócenia: Bliskie jest Królestwo Boże! Nawracajcie się! Od tego kazania minęły już wieki, a ciągle jeszcze słychać zadawane mu wtedy przez słuchaczy pytanie: Co mamy czynić? Kto odważył się na przemianę życia, prosił Jana o chrzest.

Nad Jordanem Jan ochrzcił wielu spośród tych, którzy na to odludzie przychodzili z daleka, aby go słuchać. Byli to ludzie, w których głęboko tkwiła tęsknota za przemianą, za nowym początkiem, za porzuceniem starych dróg. Żadna droga nie wydawała się zbyt długa, żadna zbyt uciążliwa, by móc chłonąć słowa Jana. W jego oczach celnicy i żołnierze byli tymi, którzy odważyli się, by dokonać w sobie przemiany. Wszystkim, którzy ciągnęli nad Jordan, Jan otwierał możliwość dzielenia własnego życia z innymi. Wszystkim głosił nadejście Królestwa Bożego, tak jakby już stało u drzwi.




