

From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

In the 6th Chapter of Mark, we find a sad verse, "He could do no mighty deed there because of their lack of faith." We must all be cautious of that attitude Our

Lord found in his own town. I speak of that stubbornness to reject something or someone who is sincerely trying to help us. Since we just celebrated America's Independence Day, it will do us well to consider what our modern culture today is rejecting from the Founding Fathers of America. Obviously, these men including Washington, Adams and Hamilton were not all saints. But there was something that the majority of them believed. John Adams said, "Our Constitution was written for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the governance of any other." Charles Carroll, another Declaration signatory and the only Catholic, said, "They who are destroying the Christian religion, whose morality is so sublime and pure.. are undermining the best security for the duration of free governments."

There are far too many examples today where Christian ethical principles are rejected like the folks of Nazareth throwing Jesus out of town. It's quite common to hear Americans say things like, "The country is falling apart." or "How did all this insanity come about?" We can, of course, concentrate on the radically anti-Christian forces that do their damage to young and old alike. But in the spirit of really appreciating the founding principles of America a more subtle problem needs fixing. In Timothy Gordon's book "Catholic Republic" he points out the fact that the key principles in the founding documents of America come from Catholic thinkers more than Protestant thinkers. Wisdom from St Thomas Aguinas, St Robert Bellarmine, and Francisco Suarez make these Catholics the true fathers of our Founding Fathers. These were the teachers who packaged the world- saving moral lessons of Christ into what the modern world grew to love

and which we still today call, "natural law".

We must not forget that one of those moral lessons is "Hate the sin while loving the sinner." But this precept is what so many in society want to throw out. Just like the folks in Nazareth, many can't even see that the wonderful world they live in would not exist if not for the underpinning of such solid Catholic morals. Unlike Nazareth, today the teachers of morality are not so much exiled as they are silenced, frequently under the culturally revered banner of tolerance. Yet this is not loving the sinner. The desire to kick Jesus out of Nazareth echoes in today's society as the desire to kick moral teachings out of the public square. With nowhere to apply these moral principles, they are effectively also removed from our churches. Although the wonderful American Spirit recognizes Thomas Jefferson's principle of the separation of church and state, we must be leery about such thinking because it can easily be construed to mean "keep Catholic morals out of our lives." Pray our nation begins to embrace good morals as we open our hearts to Christ.







Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

W szóstym rozdziale Ewangelii Marka znajduje się smutny werset: "Nie mógł tam uczynić żadnego wielkiego czynu z powodu ich niewiary." Musimy być ostrożni wobec takiej postawy, jaką nasz

Pan napotkał w swoim własnym mieście. Mówię o tej upartej odmowie przyjęcia czegoś lub kogoś, kto szczerze próbuje nam pomóc. Skoro właśnie obchodziliśmy Dzień Niepodległości Stanów Zjednoczonych, warto zastanowić się, co dzisiejsza nowoczesna kultura odrzuca z nauk Ojców Założycieli Ameryki. Oczywiście, ludzie tacy jak Washington, Adams i Hamilton nie byli świętymi. Ale jest coś, w co większość z nich wierzyła. John Adams powiedział że: "Nasza konstytucja została napisana dla ludzi moralnych i religijnych. Jest całkowicie niewystarczająca do rządzenia jakimkolwiek innym narodem." A Charles Carroll dodał że: "Ci, którzy niszczą religię chrześcijańską, której moralność jest tak wzniosła i czysta... podważają najlepsze zabezpieczenie dla trwałości wolnych rządów."

Dziś mamy zbyt wiele przykładów, gdzie chrześcijańskie zasady etyczne są odrzucane, podobnie jak mieszkańcy Nazaretu wyrzucili Jezusa z miasta. W tej kwestii wielu Amerykanów się zgadza. Wypowiadamy takie słowa jak: "Kraj się rozpada" lub "Jak doszło do tego szaleństwa?" Możemy, oczywiście, skupić się na radykalnych antychrześcijańskich siłach, które szkodzą zarówno młodym, jak i starym. Ale w duchu doceniania zasad założycielskich Ameryki, należy naprawić bardziej subtelny problem. W książce Timothy'ego Gordona "Catholic Republic" autor wskazuje, że kluczowe zasady założycielskie w dokumentach założycielskich Ameryki pochodzą bardziej od myślicieli katolickich niż protestanckich. Mądrość św. Tomasza z Akwinu, św. Roberta Bellarmina i Francisco Suareza to prawdziwi ojcowie naszych Ojców Założycieli. Byli to nauczyciele, którzy wkomponowali zbawiające świat lekcje moralne Chrystusa w to, co współczesny świat pokochał, a co nadal nazywamy dzisiaj "prawem naturalnym".

Nie możemy zapominać, że jedną z tych moralnych lekcji jest "nienawiść do grzechu przy jednoczesnej miłości do grzesznika." Ale to jest coś, co wielu w społeczeństwie chce odrzucić. Podobnie jak mieszkańcy Nazaretu, wielu nie dostrzega, że wspaniały świat, w którym żyjemy, nie istniałby, gdyby nie solidne katolickie wartości moralne. W obecnych czasach

nauczyciele moralności nie tyle są wypędzani jak uciszani. Pragnienie wyrzucenia Jezusa z Nazaretu odzwierciedla pragnienie wyrzucenia nauk moralnych z przestrzeni publicznej, a nawet z naszych kościołów. Pomimo, że wspaniały amerykański duch uznaje zasadę Thomasa Jeffersona dotyczącą rozdziału kościoła od państwa, musimy być ostrożni wobec takiego myślenia, ponieważ łatwo można je zinterpretować jako "trzymajmy katolicką moralność z dala od naszego życia."

Módlmy się, aby nasz naród zaczął przyjmować dobre zasady moralne, otwierając nasze serca na Chrystusa.




