

#### From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

Each Lent we're treated with the story of the man born blind. It's a long gospel, so I think the church is just trying to get us ready for the real long Passion reading. But there

are so many details in this narrative worth contemplating. One detail that might go unnoticed is the fact that the leaders accuse the blind man of faking his blindness all his days. Doesn't that make you want to say, "Are you kidding me? "Who goes their whole life pretending to be blind. Forcing one into a life of misery and poverty? Such a stupid accusation reinforces the fact that they hated Jesus so much that they were ready to believe the unbelievable assertion that a blind man fakes his blindness rather than believe the fact that this "man Jesus" was the Messiah. Or at least the fact that God was working miracles through Jesus.

This theme calls to mind a frequent refrain: A.B.C. That's Anything But Catholicism. It's a common refrain we hear when someone is "investigating" religions. When a person feels the need for religion in their life or already have a religion but want a better one, they will explore Buddhism or Witchcraft or even Scientology. Full disclosure, I do enjoy studying these kinds of religions, but I'm almost always left laughing or at least scratching my head thinking, "Are you kidding me?" "Who would believe this stuff? "The antiphon refrain, "ABC" echoes in my mind. These I might call the "exotic" options to Catholicism. But ABC also plays its role in the more mainstream religious quest. Maybe it has even happened to you. It is common in the world of Protestant denominations to seek out a different church when the one you're in isn't "feeding you". A Methodist will easily become a Lutheran, or a Baptist will gladly become a Presbyterian if the preaching or music or fellowship is better there. It's important to note that there is nothing "sacred" in the notion of "church" in these denominations. All the "church stuff" that you see, that is the buildings, the preacher, the music and even the fellowship are all natural, man made. So, if they're man made, they can be man broken.

This is why the question, "Who is this man Jesus?" in the Bible is very similar to the question, "What is the nature of the church?" for us. If you listen carefully to the stories of converts (The Coming Home Network on EWTN is a great place for such stories) you will often hear the refrain, "ABC". When Scott Hahn told his wife Kimberly that he wanted to become Catholic, she fell right in line. She cried, "Oh Scott, couldn't we at least become Anglican?"

Now don't get me wrong. I love Anglicans. I love Baptists and Lutherans. But no denomination thinks that its origin comes directly from the mind and workings of Jesus Christ. Because I think Jesus is not only the Messiah but also the second person in the Most Holy Trinity, I can't be satisfied with a man-made religion. I want what He wants even if it means certain sacrifices to my worldly lifestyle.



#### Lenten Regulations (Ash Wednesday, to the Paschal Triduum)

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash

Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent.
Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Those who have a medical condition in which fasting may be considered harmful, are not obliged. The special Paschal fast, as well as abstinence, are

Paschal fast, as well as abstinence, are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.

The Blessed Sacrament candle that burns above the altar 24/7 is available to be sponsored for an intention or in memory of loved ones. This candle is replaced every Monday morning. We also have a Blessed Sacrament candle in our Divine Mercy Chapel which is available for intentions. Please call our parish office to make arrangements to book your week and

call our parish office to make arrangements to book your week and to specify which Blessed Sacrament candle you would like to sponsor. A donation of \$100 is requested, and the intention along with the name of the donor will be acknowledged in our bulletin.

















#### New Kiosk News

## SS. Cyril & Methodius Parish "United in Faith"



#### Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

Każdego roku w Wielkim Poście słyszymy Ewangelię o człowieku niewidomym od urodzenia. To długa Ewangelia, więc myślę, że Kościół po prostu próbuje przygotować nas na naprawdę długą lekturę o Męce Pańskiej. W tej narracji jest

tak wiele szczegółów, które warto rozważyć. Jeden z nich, który może łatwo umknąć uwadze, to fakt, że przywódcy oskarżają niewidomego o udawanie ślepoty przez całe życie. Czytając to chce się powiedzieć: "Czy wy żartujecie?" Kto spędza całe życie, udając niewidomego? Skazując się na życie w nędzy i ubóstwie? Tak absurdalne oskarżenie pokazuje, jak bardzo nienawidzili Jezusa. Byli gotowi uwierzyć w coś tak niewiarygodnego, jak to, że człowiek przez całe życie symuluje ślepotę, zamiast uwierzyć, że "o to, ten człowiek o imieniu Jezus" jest Mesjaszem. Albo przynajmniej, że Bóg dokonuje cudów przez Niego.

Ta scena przypomina mi jeden z moich częstych refrenów: ABC – Anything But Catholicism (Cokolwiek, Byle Nie Katolicyzm). To dość powszechny motyw, który można zauważyć u osób "poszukujących" religii. Kiedy ktoś czuje, że potrzebuje religii w swoim życiu lub ma już jakąś, ale chce znaleźć "lepszą", często zaczyna eksplorować buddyzm, czary czy nawet scjentologię. Szczerze mówiąc, lubię studiować tego typu religie, ale niemal zawsze kończy się to śmiechem lub przynajmniej niedowierzaniem: "Czy wy żartujecie? Kto w to wierzy?" I wtedy w mojej głowie znów rozbrzmiewa refren ABC. Mogę to nazwać "egzotycznymi" opcjami katolicyzmu. Ale ABC odgrywa również swoją rolę w bardziej powszechnym poszukiwaniu religijnym. Może nawet to przydarzyło się Tobie. W świecie protestanckich denominacji dość powszechne jest szukanie nowego Kościoła, gdy obecny "nie karmi duchowo". Metodysta bez problemu zostanie luteraninem, baptysta chętnie przejdzie do wspólnoty prezbiteriańskiej, jeśli kazania, muzyka czy atmosfera są tam lepsze. Warto zauważyć, że w tych denominacjach nie istnieje żadne "święte" rozumienie Kościoła. Wszystko, co widzimy budynki, kaznodzieje, muzyka, wspólnota – jest czymś naturalnym, stworzonym przez ludzi. A jeśli zostało stworzone przez ludzi, to może zostać przez nich zniszczone.

Dlatego pytanie "Kim jest ten człowiek o imieniu Jezus?" w Ewangelii jest bardzo podobne do pytania "Co znaczy Kościół dla nas?". Jeśli posłuchasz uważnie historii konwertytów (polecam The Coming Home Network – Sieć Programu Domowego na kanale EWTN), gdzie często usłyszysz refren ABC. Kiedy Scott Hahn powiedział swojej żonie Kimberly, że chce zostać katolikiem, jej pierwszą reakcją było rozpaczliwe: "Och, Scott, czy nie moglibyśmy przynajmniej zostać anglikanami?"

Nie zrozum mnie źle. Kocham anglikanów, baptystów i luteranów. Ale żadna denominacja nie twierdzi, że jej początki pochodzą bezpośrednio z umysłu i działania Jezusa Chrystusa. A ponieważ wierzę, że Jezus nie tylko jest Mesjaszem, ale także Drugą Osobą Trójcy Świętej, nie mogę zadowolić się religią stworzoną przez ludzi. 




