### From the desk of Father Koys Dear Parishioners,

We hear those unforgettable words of the Prophet Simeon, "Nunc Dimittis", (now dismiss) It has the spirit of "Ok, I can die now, I've seen the beginning of

what I have longed for." First and foremost, this is the declaration that Jesus is the long awaited Savior. But Simeon's peaceful attitude in the final stage of his life can also be our prayer too.

There is a scene in The Lord of the Rings that captures this important saintly understanding of life and death. Admittedly, many who watch Tolkien's parable are left wondering, where are the Catholic themes? Allow me to share just one insight. In this famous Trilogy, we find King Theoden dying on the battlefield. Theoden, who was King of Rohan, dies fighting for the Kingdom of Gondor. This fact alone shows he has a Catholic virtue; the virtue of seeing the universal nature of his mission. In this he is somewhat like General Casmir Pulaski, who was a native Pole. He is killed on the last day of the Siege of Savannah, during the American Revolution. Both Theoden and Pulaski fight because they see the cause is just. They stand above the error of General Robert E Lee, who disliked slavery, but nonetheless fought for his "motherland", Virginia.

It was the evil Saruman who had corrupted Theoden's mind and body. The good guy, Gandalf, acts like Moses whose staff cured the Israelites from the snake bites. He brings Theoden back to his strong and kingly best with his staff. During the epic battle to save Middle Earth, we find Theoden paraphrasing Simeon. Theoden's granddaughter, Éowyn, declares, "I'm going to save you." With all the confidence of Simeon, Theoden responds, "You already did. I go to my fathers; in whose company I shall not be ashamed." It is a clean conscience and knowledge of God's mercy that allows us the grace of a peaceful death. Theoden died at peace because he saw the battle was all but won and he is dying a

hero and not a coward.

Like Simeon, you and I become heroes when we stand up in public and declare Christ is King. This powerful tale pushes us to contemplate our preparedness for eternity. What is it that we long for? What is it that we are willing to fight for? To die for? Do we long for the reign of Our Lord today?

And now I want to say something directly to any young adult Catholic who maybe reading this and who is living with their "significant other". As I ponder Simeon's prayer, I cannot help but think of a thousand mothers who long to see their son or daughter marry in the Catholic church. If I've heard it once, I've heard it a hundred times, "I only wish, that before I die, my precious child, would come back to the church and get married."

There is a real connection between these two prayers. Jesus lived and died to establish His church so don't be afraid dear young ones to take that step into reality. When we declare boldly that marriage is a sacrament, we declare Christ is king.



### A Note From Cardinal Blasé Cupich

The Church teaches that receiving Holy Communion is not a private action but a communal one, as the very word "communion" implies. For that reason the norm established by Holy See for the universal Church and approved by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops is for

the faithful to process together as an expression of their coming forward as the Body of Christ and to receive Holy Communion standing. Processions are an ancient practice of the Church and have been part of the liturgy from the earliest days, assisting the faithful to always keep in mind that we are a pilgrim people, making our way together to the fulness of the heavenly banquet Christ has prepared for us. We process into the church. We process up to bring the gifts. We process to receive Holy Communion. We process out to carry the Lord into the world.

Nothing should be done to impede this sacred ritual of receiving communion or diminish its powerful symbol by disrupting an important moment in which the faithful, in processing together, express their faith that they are called to become the very Body of Christ they receive. Certainly reverence can and should be expressed by bowing before the reception of Holy Communion, but no one should engage in a gesture that calls attention to oneself or disrupts the flow of the procession by assuming another posture. That would be contrary to the norms and tradition of the church, which all the faithful are urged to respect and observe.

### Z biurka wikariusza pastora Drodzy Parafianie,

Wsłuchajmy się w te niezapomniane słowa proroka Symeona: "Nunc Dimittis" ("teraz pozwól odejść"). Niosą one w sobie ducha: "W porządku, teraz mogę umrzeć, widziałem początek tego, na co tak długo czekałem." Przede

wszystkim jest to deklaracja, że Jezus jest długo wyczekiwanym Zbawicielem. Ale spokojna postawa Symeona w ostatnim etapie jego życia może stać się także naszą modlitwa.

W powieści Władcy Pierścieni jest scena, która oddaje to święte zrozumienie życia i śmierci. Wielu, oglądając przypowieść Tolkiena, zastanawia się, gdzie są katolickie motywy. A więc pozwólcie, że podzielę się jednym spostrzeżeniem. W tej słynnej trylogii widzimy, jak król Théoden umiera na polu bitwy. Théoden, król Rohanu, ginie walcząc o królestwo Gondoru. Sam ten fakt pokazuje, że posiada katolicką cnotę – cnotę dostrzegania powszechnej natury swojej misji. Jego zachowanie można również porównać do postawy generała Kazimierza Pułaskiego, który był Polakiem i zginął na polu bitwy ostatniego dnia oblężenia Savannah podczas rewolucji amerykańskiej. Podobnie Théoden, jak i Pułaski walczą w przekonaniu o bardzo ważną sprawę. Wznoszą się ponad błąd generała Roberta E. Lee, który nie pochwalał niewolnictwa, ale mimo to walczył za swoją "ojczyznę" – Wirginię.

To zły Saruman zdeprawował umysł i ciało Théodena. Dobry Gandalf działa niczym Mojżesz, którego rózga uzdrawiała Izraelitów od ukąszeń węży. Przywraca

Théodena do jego dawnej królewskiej świetności. Podczas epickiej bitwy o ocalenie Śródziemia, Théoden parafrazuje Symeona. Wnuczka Théodena, Éowyn, mówi: "Zamierzam cię uratować." Z całą pewnością Symeona Théoden odpowiada: "Już to zrobiłaś. Idę do moich ojców, w których towarzystwie nie będę się wstydził." Czyste sumienie i świadomość Bożego miłosierdzia dają nam łaskę spokojnej śmierci. Théoden umiera w pokoju, ponieważ widzi, że bitwa jest niemal wygrana, a on umiera jako bohater, a nie tchórz.

Podobnie jak Symeon, Ty i ja stajemy się bohaterami, gdy publicznie ogłaszamy, że Chrystus jest Królem. Ta potężna opowieść skłania nas do rozważań nad naszym przygotowaniem na wieczność i zadania sobie kilku pytań. Za czym tęsknimy? O co jesteśmy gotowi walczyć? Za co umrzeć? Czy pragniemy panowania naszego Pana już dziś?

Teraz chcę zwrócić się bezpośrednio do młodych katolików, którzy mogą to czytać i żyją ze swoją "drugą połówką". Rozważając modlitwę Symeona, turdno ominąć myśl o tysiącach matek, które pragną zobaczyć, jak ich syn lub córka zawiera małżeństwo w Kościele katolickim. Jeśli usłyszałem to raz, słyszałem to setki razy: "Jedynym moim życzeniem, zanim umrę, jest to, aby moje ukochane dziecko wróciło do Kościoła i wzięło ślub."

Istnieje prawdziwe połączenie między tymi dwoma modlitwami. Jezus żył i umarł, aby ustanowić swój Kościół, więc nie bójcie się, drodzy młodzi, zrobić tego kroku ku rzeczywistości. Kiedy odważnie deklarujemy, że małżeństwo jest sakramentem, ogłaszamy, że Chrystus jest Królem.



### Where Are These Holy Doors for the Jubilee Year?

The Vatican announced that, for the 2025 Jubilee of Hope that five "Holy Doors" have been opened, just as Pope Francis opened the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. The official five Holy Doors were specified by Pope Francis when he officially proclaimed the 2025 Ordinary Jubilee. The Holy Doors will be located at the Basilica of St. Peter, the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, and

the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls. A fifth door will also be located at the Rebibbia Prison in Rome, which Pope Francis opened himself.


Here in the Archdiocese of Chicago, we can join with the Universal Church in prayer and pilgrimage throughout this Jubilee year. Cardinal Cupich opened the Jubilee Year locally by celebrating a special Mass at Holy Name Cathedral on December 29, 2024. • St. Veronica in Flossmoor






Can't make it to Rome or even out of town? Yes, you can get these blessings if you are homebound.


